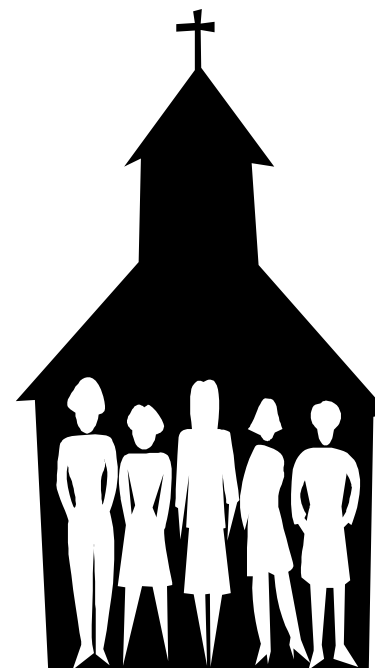


What Is The Lutheran Women's Missionary League?

- ❖ It is the official women's auxiliary of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS). It is women in mission who are finding avenues to use their God-given talents as they meet the challenge to share the Gospel message and who are daily dedicating their lives to making a difference in this world.
- ❖ A major emphasis is the support of mission and ministry throughout the world by means of MITE BOX offerings. These MITE BOX offerings have funded tens of millions of dollars in mission grants since the LWML's inception in 1942.
- ❖ **THE MITE BOX!!** Based on the Biblical account of the widow's Mite (Luke 21:1-4), the MITE BOX is intended for regular contributions of "MITES" – offerings above and beyond the support given to the congregation and the Synod. MITE BOX contributions amount to millions of dollars that fund district and national mission grants and implement the LWML program.

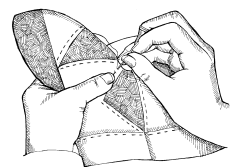
