## MISSION POSITION:

The position was created as a ministry of Redeemer Lutheran Church through the understanding that the church has a role in healing which has been recognized since earliest Christianity. The very nature of the church is to be a healing community in the wholistic concept of recognizing health encompassing body, mind and spirit. The person filling this position will embody this concept in his/her nursing care and ministry within the Redeemer Lutheran congregation stressing health maintenance, illness prevention, and compassionate support for those members with health concerns.

This position is designed to provide leadership in identifying and meeting the health education and counseling needs of the members of the congregation and our community.

## PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Prepares and teaches or coordinates courses and/or seminars to the congregation on health maintenance, disease prevention and early detection through screening.
2. Acts as a personal counselor to members of the congregation assessing health problems, referring, educating and visiting as appropriate recognizing individual choices.

3. Maintains records for program assessment and evaluation.
4. Coordinates volunteers who will assist in meeting the goals of the program.
5. Participates in continuing education programs for mutual support and program planning
6. Attends monthly meetings with Redeemer Parish Nurses.
7. Scope of Parish Nurse—Not a pastor, Stephen Minister or Home Health Nurse.

3. Has completed Foundation Parish Nurse Course.
